<p>Please give a clear description of your request:</p>	<p>APITI HALL Apiti Hall was once the hub of the community and with careful upgrade will again become a comfortable, user-friendly hub. *New 33,000 litre water tank including pump and filter system to replace the old, leaking concrete tank that does not deliver potable water and is therefore a health hazard. This will give the hall and public toilets a permanent water supply - approx \$5,500. *Install secondary double-glazing to Hall's Supper Room and a heat pump. This will upgrade the current wall-mounted bar heaters which are expensive and inefficient to run. The upgraded glazing will also afford some insulation to retain heat - approx \$10,000. Replace the outside windows in the hall toilets with new windows. The current windows are fixed glass louver windows than cannot be closed and in winter make the toilets so cold that the water in the bowls has been known to freeze. *Upgrade the kitchen by putting in under-bench shelving, wall shelving for microwave oven, replace pie-warmer, replace floor covering. This will make the space so that it is a more user-friendly by being brighter, easier to use and easier to keep clean - approx \$8,000. *Put in French Doors on the church side of the Hall, along with a covered deck area and picnic tables. This will enhance the use of the Hall for fine-weather group activities - cost not known *WiFi installed. This will be an asset for groups using the Hall and enhance its user-friendliness - installation & ongoing costs not known. *Resurface the floor in the main body of the Hall; repaint the main body to lift it up to be brighter, more welcoming space - approx \$12,000 *Upgrade lighting in main body of the hall so that there is good light. Also allow for festoon lights for functions - cost unknown.</p>



<p>Please give a clear description of your request:</p>	<p>ROADS</p> <p>*The bridge over the Oroua River, which is where Oroua Valley Road begins is known locally as the White Bridge. It is in need of painting. The barrier on the approach needs to be repainted to show up more and maybe signage to alert drivers coming around the approaching that there is a bend in the road. Re-position the yellow reflector on the pillar of the bridge so that it is closer to the road. Currently the approach on the Apiti Road side of the road is confusing.</p> <p>*Three more barriers between this bridge and Apiti Village need repainting. They are at the 35km bend, opposite 620 Oroua Valley Rd driveway and near 559 Oroua Valley Rd, towards the village.</p> <p>*A bike lane along the main road would make it safer for the many bikers who use this route and share it with stock trucks, milk tankers etc.</p> <p>*The Oroua Valley Road/Bryce Street/Makoura Road block has a footpath only half way around. There are now dwelling owners in most of that block as well as Apiti School. The footpath needs to go around the whole block (see attachment 1.)</p> <p>*An extension of the current footpath from the Oroua Valley Rd/Bryce St intersection to the end of the village towards Main South Road.</p> <p>*Maintenance of the Oroua Valley Rd footpath between Makoura Rd and Balance St. This footpath has some areas that need repaving and areas that need the moss & lichen removed to make walking safe.</p> <p>*A roundabout in the middle of the main intersection, even if it was painted, will give a definition and help traffic control.</p> <p>*To help with traffic control we would like to see the speed limit though the village reduced to 50km/hour.</p> <p>*A focus of the Apiti Community Committee is that Apiti be a Destination Point. To help this we would like to have at least one outlook over the Oroua Valley and possibly a second outlook over the Apiti valley. (Attachment s 2 & 3).</p>
