## Agenda topics for discussion

3. Minute 2 of the Hearing Panel appointed to consider Private Plan Change 1 to the Manawatū District Plan (PPC1) requested that:

Following receipt of the stormwater experts' JWS, the Requestor's and the Manawatū District Council's (Council) planning experts are requested to undertake expert

conferencing and prepare a JWS to address the planning matters arising from the

stormwater experts' JWS.

4. In accordance with Minute 3, the JWS is requested to be provided no later than

4pm Wednesday 3 May 2023

5. The overarching question for the SW Experts was whether the stormwater

management approach proposed by PPC1 is feasible, noting that detailed design

will occur at the consenting stage.

6. The agenda for the stormwater engineers traversed matters that were subject to

discussions at pre application meetings with Horizon Regional Council staff. The

meeting also provided the opportunity for the engineers to consider further

information provided by a geotechnical engineer to assist in their consideration

of the feasibility of the proposed stormwater management approach.

7. We considered the JWS produced by the stormwater expert witnesses and their

respective summary comments. During our discussion, we acknowledged the

engineers' expertise in this area and the agreement reached by all JWS

participants that subject to further consenting and detailed design, a stormwater

treatment pond (Option A or B) could feasibly be constructed within the plan

change area.

8. We were in agreement that no further changes to the plan change provisions are

required, based on the position of the engineers.
